



August Guidance - Connect & Collaborate

One of the most powerful tools and abilities you can possess as you strive to do work that matters to you is to be able to connect with others. And what better location to start to practice than at your own local Live Your Legend meetup!

So this month we want to encourage even deeper connectedness within your local communities. We are going to guide you on how to create a local community who truly knows one another. Because when we know each other, we can truly open up the space for potential collaboration and friendships.

So August is themed CONNECT & COLLABORATE.

Host to facilitate asking the following questions. Be sure to ask participants to stand up (if possible) and find someone they don't know, or if a small group simply pair up.

Remind them that this is a safe place of no judgement and give them a little hint that they need to have their best listening ears on for this activity!

Question #1: Share with your partner what brought you here tonight.

Host guidance: After 1-2 mins blow a whistle, holler, tap the side of a glass, etc. to gain their attention and ask them to switch turns if they haven't already.

Question #2: What would you say is one of your top natural talents or strengths?

Question #3: What is your favorite holiday?

Host guidance: After 1-2 mins blow a whistle, holler, tap the side of a glass, etc. to gain their attention and ask them to switch turns if they haven't already.

Question #4: What is your greatest fear?

Host guidance: After 1-2 mins blow a whistle, holler, tap the side of a glass, etc. to gain their attention and ask them to switch turns if they haven't already.

Once you have run through these 4 questions and each partner has had a chance to share, go around the room and ask each person what they learned about their partner. If you have a group larger than 12, then invite only 3-4 people to share.

Finally, invite the group to seek out anyone from the event who has a talent or skill that they need or want to learn more about, and open the space for natural collaborations to occur!
